COOL CATS

Catamarans, whether power or sail, make an outstanding platform for charter. They're stable with big interior spaces for guest use, and while they used to be found primarily in the British Virgin Islands, they're now branching out to offer charter itineraries throughout the Caribbean and beyond. **01 CLOUDS** is a 70-foot Sunreef Power cat whose owner specified megayacht-style upgrades, including a Turkish *hammam*, that set her apart on the charter market. sunreef-charter.com **02 NECKER BELLE**, owned by Sir Richard Branson, is a 105-foot CMN that has been known to top 20 knots under sail. (We'd expect nothing less from the billionaire, who has made several record-breaking attempts to cross oceans.) burgessyachts.com **03 SPLIT SECOND** launched earlier this year and is a new offering for this winter in the Caribbean. At 62 feet length overall, the Lagoon takes eight guests in four queen-bed cabins — ideal for a group of adults. blue-latitude-yachting.com **04 QUARANTA** is a 111-foot Curvelle power cat that serves as the company's flagship. She launched in 2013, making her one of the newer cats for charter worldwide today. curvelle.com **05 NEMO**, at 47 feet length overall, is small but noteworthy among crewed charter yachts because her owner-operators go to great lengths ensuring she is among the most eco-friendly yachts of any size in the world. She's built by Nautitech and accommodates eight guests. selectyachts.com
